SUBJECT: e-Notification Application Migrating to Ginnie Mae's
Enterprise Portal

Ginnie Mae's Enterprise Portal (GMEP) will eventually be the single access point for program participants to conduct online business with Ginnie Mae. As such, Ginnie Mae is continuing its ongoing effort to migrate its business applications into the GMEP. On December 1, 2009, the e-Notification application will be migrated to the portal environment.

All Issuers and Document Custodians must register for access to the portal. Issuers that have already obtained GMEP user accounts for RFS reporting are not required to obtain new GMEP user accounts, as their accounts are valid on the GMEP website. Instructions on how to register for the GMEP are available in the Mortgage-Backed Securities Guide, Appendix III-29.

All Document Custodians must register at least two Security Officers for portal access before December 1, 2009. Security Officers will then be able to register users to access e-Notification. Please do this as soon as possible. Document Custodians may download the portal registration application from http://www.ginniemae.gov/guide/pdf/app_iii-29.pdf, complete the form, and mail the form with original signatures to:
