SUBJECT: Ginnie Mae's Business Applications Migrating from e-Access to Ginnie Mae Enterprise Portal

Ginnie Mae continues to migrate its remaining legacy business applications to its Ginnie Mae Enterprise Portal (GMEP). Below are updates to future changes taking place with regard to accessing Ginnie Mae's Loan Matching and e-Notification business applications.

Loan Matching

Effective April 1, 2010, Issuers will no longer be able to access Loan Matching feedback through e-Access. Instead, Issuers must use the RFS Matching and Suspense module within GMEP, in order to access feedback on Loan Matching.

e-Notification

Currently, the e-Notification application is available in both GMEP and e-Access. Effective April 1, 2010, Issuers will no longer be able to access e-Notification through e-Access; e-Notification will only be accessible via GMEP. Per APM 09-19, dated November 12, 2009, all Issuers (including HMBS Issuers) and Document Custodians must register for the GMEP, in order to access e-Notification. See Ginnie Mae Mortgage-Backed Securities Guide 5500.3, Rev.1, Appendix III-29, for portal registration instructions.

e-Access

Issuers should be aware that WHFIT Tax Reporting and HMBS Pool Accounting business applications will continue to be accessed through e-Access until otherwise notified in writing.
