UPCOMING POLICY UPDATES

Updates to loan file release procedures

- Format updates to accommodate batch releases
- Electronic signatures

Documentation updates for Pilot Program rules

- Guidance for custodian review of single-close note
(i.e. USDA Single Construction Loans)

Potential documentation requirements for VA refinances

- Dependent on implementation of final rules.

UPCOMING POLICY UPDATES

Acceptability of trailing document electronic or digital equivalents

- *i.e.* Electronically recorded security instruments
- *i.e.* Digital copy of title policy

Draft guidance for certification of loan packages comprised of eNotes

- Layout responsibilities between Issuers and custodians
- Limited in scope to specific pilot scenarios (*i.e.* no CEMAs or ARMs)
- Will have specific associated RFI
