Account Inactivity	An indicator that a user has not logged in to an account, which must occur at least every 90 days to avoid the account being automatically <u>disabled</u> . An <u>End User</u> must contact an <u>Organization Administrator</u> to have the account re-enabled and <u>functional</u> <u>roles</u> reassigned. An <u>Organization Administrator</u> must contact the <u>Operations</u> <u>Administrator</u> via the <u>Ginnie Mae Customer Support Hotline</u> to have the account re- enabled and the security privileges reassigned.
Authenticated User	A user whose credentials have been validated and thereby successfully logged in to the MyGinnieMae portal.
Avatar	The icon used represent a particular person in the <u>MyGinnieMae</u> portal. Selecting the avatar allows the user to access and manage their user profile.

Data Analysis and Reporting Tool (DART)	An <u>RFS</u> data querying tool that retrieves historical pool and loan data that Ginnie Mae users can use to gain a better understanding of past performance of Mortgage-Backed Securities (MBS). Default ID	The user ID that will automatically be used by <u>MyGinnieMae</u> to provide an <u>authenticated user</u> access to systems and applications, such as <u>GMEP 1.0</u> and <u>GinnieNET</u> . This ID is established at account creation and used by the system behind the scenes. The users only need to know their <u>Username</u> to access the portal.

Employee Contact List	A list of Ginnie Mae employee contact information. Ginnie Mae users can update their mobile numbers. All other data must be updated by the Administrators. End User	MyGinnieMae portal users that have been assigned a <u>functional role</u> , such as Ginnie Mae employees, business partners and contractors who require access to the business applications and information within the portal.
Enterprise ID (Username)	The <u>Username</u> used by <u>End Users</u> to access the <u>MyGinnieMae</u> portal. The portal will only allow one user to be registered for each email address. The ID must be an email address that is unique to the user.
Entitlement	A condition or provision that, together with application or system roles, make up an <u>underlying role</u> in the <u>MyGinnieMae</u> portal.

Forgot Password?	A link located on the <u>Login Page</u> that redirects a user to the page in the portal that will allow them to reset their password. (See <u>Figure 3.0</u> )
Functional Role	A system access profile based on business activities used to ensure <u>End Users</u> have the appropriate level of access to be able to perform their job functions and responsibilities. Functional roles are grouped and vary by type (refer to the <u>Functional</u> <u>Role Matrix</u> ).
Ginnie Mae Enterprise Portal (GMEP 1.0)	The <u>legacy system</u> for Issuers, Subservicers and Document Custodians to access Ginnie Mae systems for monthly reporting, pool transfers, managing master agreements, and other tasks associated with the MBS programs. GNMA	The Government National Mortgage Association (commonly referred to as Ginnie Mae and abbreviated to GNMA) is a U.S. government corporation that guarantees the timely payment of principal and interest on mortgage-backed securities (MBSs) issued by approved Ginnie Mae lenders.
HMBS Reporting and Administration (HRA)	The <u>RFS</u> module used by an Issuer's authorized signer for HECM Mortgage-Backed Securities (HMBS) to make a new monthly reporting certification or remove a certification so they can replace it with a new one. Issuers can also view prior monthly reporting certifications. Location <u>Global Header</u> > <u>Tools</u> > <u>RFS&gt;</u> HRA
Home Organization (Home Org ID)	The organization that a user's account is registered with (usually the organization that employs the user). The Home Organization is set in <u>AMC</u> by the <u>Organization</u> <u>Administrator</u> on the New User Registration Form in the 'Org ID' field when a user is invited to register for <u>MyGinnieMae</u> . A user can have access to multiple <u>Organization</u> <u>IDs</u> , but only one can be the user's Home Organization ID.

Issuer Operational Performance Profile (IOPP)	An <u>RFS</u> tool that helps Issuers better understand Ginnie Mae's expectations and the metrics that Ginnie Mae uses. Knowledge Center	A repository for viewing and downloading approved tools and resources. The Knowledge Center is managed by the Ginnie Mae Content Manager.
Leadership Blog	Ginnie Mae leadership may use blog posts to communicate industry events and information and Ginnie Mae announcements with the <u>MyGinnieMae</u> user community. Location <u>Global Header</u> > <u>Communities</u> > Leadership Blog

Modernized Systems/ Applications	Emerging technology that Ginnie Mae is implementing to update its Securitization Platform technology, processes, and related policies in response to the growing need for increased transparency and improved service delivery to its Issuers and investors. An example of a modernized application is the Multi-Family Pool Delivery Module (MFPDM).
Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)	A security system that requires more than one method of authentication from independent categories of credentials to verify a user's identity. This ensures that the appropriate security controls and context are established prior to conducting business. This is also referred to as <u>Second Factor Authentication</u> in the portal. The <u>MyGinnieMae</u> portal uses a <u>One-Time PIN (OTP)</u> for multi-factor authentication.
Multi-Factor Authentication Page	A portal page where users are directed when entering their credentials to input the <u>One-Time PIN (OTP)</u> delivered through email or from Oracle Mobile Authenticator.

My Dashboard	A tailored landing page that an <u>End User</u> is directed to upon authentication. This page is the central area to preview all the <u>MyGinnieMae</u> news, updates, activities and messages in the portal. The features available on each My Dashboard are tailored to different <u>functional roles</u> .
My Profile	A self-service interface to manage a user profile, where users can go to change passwords, update phone numbers, edit job titles and other information specific to the user. If the user has multiple <u>Organization IDs</u> linked to their user profile, they can change the Org ID they work under from My Profile.
Office of Securities Operations (OSO)	The HUD office responsible for three major business functions: Ginnie Mae Mortgage Backed Securities Operations; Ginnie Mae's Transformation and Modernization effort; and Ginnie Mae's Program Administration/Customer Outreach.
Onboarding Workflow	An invitation model used to request and approve user registration and access to <u>functional roles</u> . This model employs <u>Segregation of Duties</u> that requires more than one system administrator to onboard a single user.
One-Time PIN (OTP)	A factor in Ginnie Mae's <u>Multi-Factor authentication</u> process which requires more than one method of authentication to ensure the proper security controls are established. Provides an additional level of security for access to Ginnie Mae business applications by receipt of a single-use PIN sent through email or from the Oracle Mobile Authenticator (OMA).
Operations Administrator (Ops Admin)	Privileged users that have general oversight over the portal. The Bank of New York Mellon via the <u>Ginnie Mae Customer Support Hotline</u> acts as the Operations Administrator for <u>MyGinnieMae</u> on behalf of Ginnie Mae. Operations Administrators set up and manage all <u>Organization Administrator</u> accounts, finalize all <u>End User</u> access requests, and unlock users' <u>OTP</u> accounts. The Operations Administrator may not manage or make changes to <u>End User</u> accounts or reset passwords; those functions must be completed by an <u>Organization</u> <u>Administrator</u> .

Oracle Mobile Authenticator (OMA)	A mobile application that enables you to securely verify your identity by using your smart device as an authentication factor for <u>Multi-Factor Authentication</u> . The app generates six-digit <u>One-Time PINs</u> (OTP) that are valid for 30 seconds for login.
Organization Administrator (Org Admin)	A privileged user who controls system access, assigns <u>functional roles</u> and performs other user management activities in <u>MyGinnieMae</u> for an organization. This is the person that an <u>End User</u> should go to first when experiencing issues in the portal. Each organization must have at least two Organization Administrators set up. If Organization Administrators will also be business application users requiring <u>functional role</u> assignment associated with their <u>MyGinnieMae</u> user ID, then a third Organization Administrator is required. Organization Administrators would have performed the Security Officer role in <u>GMEP1.0</u> or the Enrollment Administrator role in <u>GinnieNET</u> .
Organization Administrator Group	A group of all the <u>Organization Administrators</u> for a specific organization based on <u>Organization ID</u> .
Business Organization ID (Organization ID) (Org ID)	The ID that identifies an organization, also referred to as <u>Issuer ID</u> or Custodian ID. A user can have multiple Org IDs. If a user has multiple Organization IDs, the user must select the appropriate <u>Issuer ID</u> from <u>My Profile</u> before navigating to business applications.
Organization Key (Org Key)	A unique identifier for each organization comprised of the organization name, type and Org ID.
Password	A group of characters created by a user at registration that allows access to the <u>MGM</u> portal when entered on the <u>Login Page</u> (Figure 3.0) in conjunction with a <u>Username</u> . The password may be changed via the Change Security Settings link in <u>My Profile</u> .
Password Expiration	A password will expire 90 days from the date it was last set or changed. The password may be changed via the Change Security Settings link in <u>My Profile</u> .
Platinum Pool Processing Application	The application that provides an interface for depositors creating new Platinum pools. The Platinum Pool Processing Application enables depositors to track the status of Platinum pool requests and other pending actions.
Pool Accounting/Exception Feedback (PA/EF)	The RFS modules that support streamlined data collection, feedback and reporting for Single Family (SF) and Multifamily (MF) MBS post-settlement activities. Exception Reports are sent to Issuers to correct any data quality errors. The list of errors can be found in the Ginnie Mae Guide. This ensures that the appropriate security controls and context are established prior to conducting business. This is also referred to as <u>Multi-Factor Authentication</u> in the portal. Self-Service Password Management	The feature that allows users to change their password via <u>My Profile</u> or set a new password via <u>Forgot Password</u> if they have forgotten their password. The user will be required to enter an <u>OTP</u> to change their password.	
Session Manager	The Session Manager contains the <u>Session Timer</u> , the ' <u>Extend</u> ' button and the ' <u>Log Out</u> ' button. To access the Session Manager, select the lock icon from the <u>Global</u> <u>Header</u> .
