As of March 06, 2020, the Bank of New York Mellon Trust, ID number 0350 (BNYM) was no longer an approved Ginnie Mae Document Custodian participant within the Ginnie Mae program.

All Issuers affected by this announcement were asked to select another Ginnie Mae approved document custodian, execute Master Agreement Form HUD-11715 within MAMS, and perform a Transfer of Custodial Responsibility from BNYM as of March 1, 2021. Such Transfer of Custodial Responsibility must encompass all pools and loan packages held by BNYM for each Issuer as of the effective date of the Transfer.

The purpose of this communication is to inform the affected issuers the deadline for completing this transfer from BNYM to another Document Custodian has been extended from March 1, 2021 to August 1, 2021.
