Internet Browser

- As of October 16, 2013, support for users running the Ginnie Mae Enterprise Portal (GMEP)using Microsoft's Internet Explorer 7 will no longer be available.
- Beginning on October 16, Ginnie Mae will support GMEP running under the following browser versions:
 - Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 (For users on the Microsoft Windows XP Operating System)
 - <u>Microsoft Internet Explorer 9</u> (For users on Microsoft Windows 7 Operating System) <– Preferred platform going forward.
- No other browser versions, including Microsoft Internet Explorer 10, Firefox, or Google Chrome, will be supported at this time.
- For users of the fingerprint device that is used for authentication in Ginnie *NET*, the scanner device will work with both Windows XP and Windows 7 and IE 8 and IE 9. However, at this time, the fingerprint scanning device will only work with the 32 bit versions of Windows 7 and IE 9.



Introducing RSA Tokens

- RSA Tokens will be used for the new functionality only
- Commitment Authority Request, Master Agreement Management, Pool Transfer System actions will require use of the token
- Security Officers are required to obtain tokens
- GinnieNET will continue to use fingerprint biometric device
- An APM outlining the next steps is forthcoming.
